

**PRAYER FOR ILLUMINATION**

**OLD TESTAMENT:** Exodus 17:1-7

17 From the wilderness of Sin the whole congregation of the  
Israelites journeyed by stages, as the LORD commanded. They  
camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to  
drink. <sup>2</sup>The people quarreled with Moses, and said, "Give us  
water to drink." Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with  
me? Why do you test the LORD?" <sup>3</sup>But the people thirsted there  
for water; and the people complained against Moses and said,  
"Why did you bring us out of Egypt, to kill us and our children  
and livestock with thirst?" <sup>4</sup>So Moses cried out to the LORD,  
"What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to  
stone me." <sup>5</sup>The LORD said to Moses, "Go on ahead of the  
people, and take some of the elders of Israel with you; take in  
your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. <sup>6</sup>I

will be standing there in front of you on the rock at Horeb.  
Strike the rock, and water will come out of it, so that the people  
may drink." Moses did so, in the sight of the elders of Israel. <sup>7</sup>He  
called the place Massah and Meribah, because the Israelites  
quarreled and tested the LORD, saying, "Is the LORD among us or  
not?"

**NEW TESTAMENT:** 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 1:10-15, 17; 3:5-7

<sup>10</sup>Now I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our  
Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you be in agreement and that there  
be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same  
mind and the same purpose. <sup>11</sup>For it has been reported to me  
by Chloe's people that there are quarrels among you, my  
brothers and sisters. <sup>12</sup>What I mean is that each of you says, "I  
belong to Paul," or "I belong to Apollos," or "I belong to  
Cephas," or "I belong to Christ." <sup>13</sup>Has Christ been divided? Was  
Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of  
Paul? <sup>14</sup>I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus  
and Gaius, <sup>15</sup>so that no one can say that you were baptized in  
my name. <sup>17</sup>For Christ did not send me to baptize but to  
proclaim the gospel, and not with eloquent wisdom, so that the  
cross of Christ might not be emptied of its power. <sup>5</sup>What then is  
Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to  
believe, as the Lord assigned to each. <sup>6</sup>I planted, Apollos  
watered, but God gave the growth. <sup>7</sup>So neither the one who  
plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who  
gives the growth.
