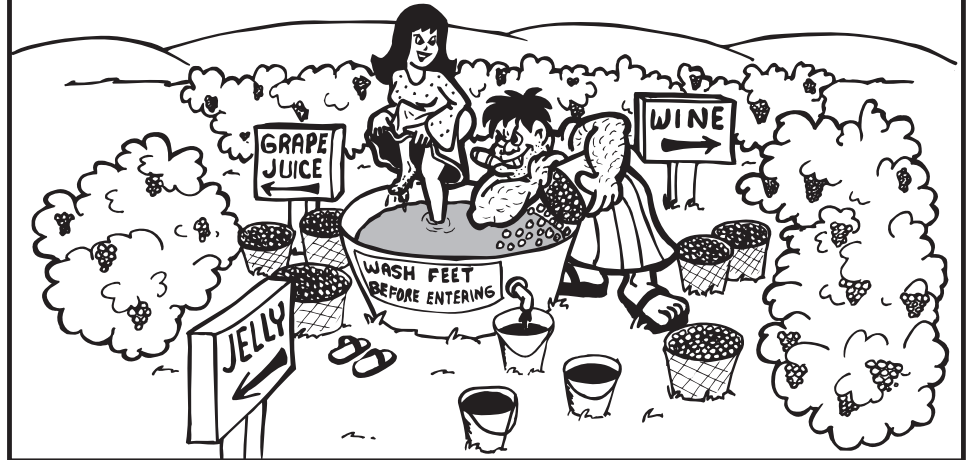


HE BOUGHT SOME GOOD LAND, BUILT A FENCE, BOUGHT SOME VINES,

Draw a vineyard with workers in it.

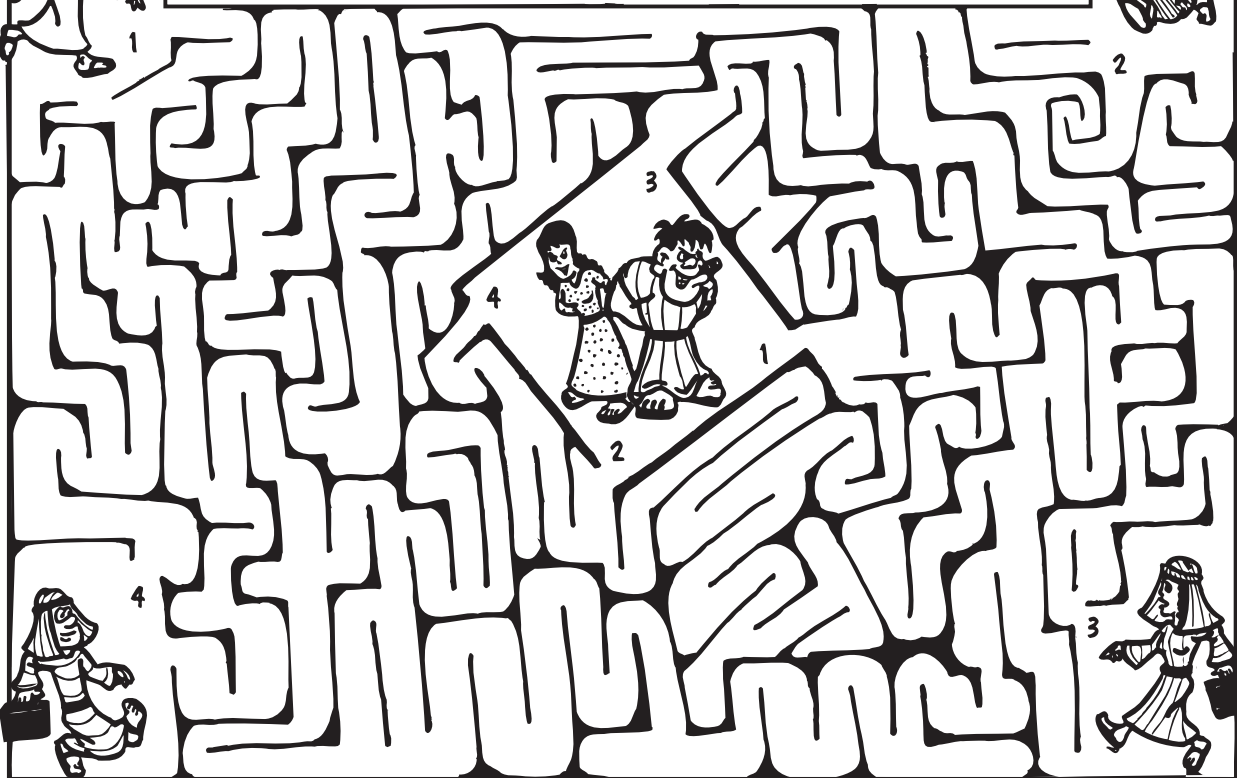


THEN HE HIRED TRUSTED WORKERS TO TAKE CARE OF IT (WHY, ALL, NOW);
